The Red Stags are now pretty much ready! We have a healthy population on the Estate and the sound of the Stags roaring in the early morning and evening is fantastic to hear! High Seats

High seats are ideal for the less mobile Guns or for those who do not wish to stalk the whole three hours. You have a choice of spending the whole time Stalking, and taking a shot from sticks, or the whole time in one or more High Seats or a

News from our stalking guides - Paul and Charlie

"What has happened in the last few months stalking here on the estate?"

Stalking got off to a steady start on the roe bucks in April with us not taking clients until towards the end of the month when most of the heads had cleaned. We did however have some good stalking on muntjac buck with some nice trophies taken and we spotted one exceptional head, which had a habit of showing himself when we were looking for something else.

Into May and the roe bucks showing up well despite crops and vegetation getting rather high. On one weekend trip, three clients managed to shoot five roe buck and six muntjac in three outings. Nothing spectacular in the trophies, but some good stalking and great shooting on the part of the clients.

June saw a quiet time, with us taking the chance to get out and see what was showing up and planning for the rut, moving high seats into likely spots to produce a buck. The rut seemed to start about a week earlier than last year, which gave us a opportunity to assess bucks closely before the first booked in clients arrived with us. This proved worthwhile after spotting an exceptional buck which had moved in for the rut!. Three weeks during the rut with clients produced about twenty bucks of which two were outstanding for our area, plus a few oddies which the clients were very pleased with.

The last few weeks has seen us out after the muntjac bucks and picking up some cull roe buck as well. These at times have proved difficult to catch up with due to weather and high vegetation.

At present we have been spending time out watching reds before the rut which will be starting anytime, seeing stags and hearing some roaring but again weather still wet and mild, not too much activity as yet. The anticipation of hearing the stags and seeing the clients when the big fellows show, makes for a great time just around the corner.

Looking forward to catching up with some of the regular clients and meeting some new faces over the coming weeks." -- Paul and Charlie
